Artwork must be ready to hang wire and screw hooks or Drog for heavier pieces (weight 35 bs.), no sawtooth hangers or other hanging hardware. Maximum dimensions including frame, up to 65" width, 60" height. Artists should label all artwork with name, address and telephone number.
